



## **Downsview Park's 6<sup>th</sup> Annual 3-on-3 Street Hockey Tournament**

### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### **1. When is the event?**

Saturday, January 30, 2010

9:00 AM – 5:00 PM\*

\*Precise event schedule will depend on total number of teams registered and numbers of games scheduled.

#### **2. What is this event?**

Downsview Park's 3-on-3 Street Hockey Tournament is a day-long tournament among community ball hockey teams from across Ontario. The tournament is held annually at Downsview Park in Toronto in partnership with the Ontario Ball Hockey Association. The tournament raises funds for Shoot for a Cure.

In addition to the tournament's regular division competition, there is an additional "Downsview Park Canada Cup" which will involve teams invited to participate, from across Canada.

**4. How much does it cost to register?**

For one team, the registration fee is \$150.

**5. When is the registration deadline?**

January 15, 2010 – Register early as this event fills up fast!

**7. Can single players sign up?**

No. Only teams may register.

**8. Can teams register from across Canada? If not, what is the boundary for registration entries.**

For tournament competition, teams may originate from anywhere in Ontario.

For the Downsview Park Canada Cup, teams from across Canada will be invited to attend. Teams may not sign themselves up for the Downsview Park Canada Cup competition.

**9. Who gets the proceeds from the tournament?**

A portion of each team's registration fee is donated to Shoot for a Cure, a charity committed to finding a cure for spinal cord injuries. One hundred percent of funds raised through team pledges go to Shoot for a Cure.

### **10. When will my team receive their game schedule?**

Team captains will receive their team's game schedule at the pre-registration session (see dates and times in question 15). Game schedules will also be emailed to team captains the week before the tournament.

### **11. What equipment MUST I wear/can I wear?**

### **12. How many players are permitted on each team?**

Each team must have a minimum of 4 players, and can have a maximum of 7 players.

### **13. How do I know which division my team should register for?**

Youth divisions are based on the age of the players. Please review the *Registration Form* for the permitted age ranges of each youth division.

Adult divisions are based on players' skill level. Please register your team in accordance to the skills level at which you wish to compete. If you have any questions about adult division registration, please call Mauro Cugini, Ontario Ball Hockey Association, 905-738-3320.

### **14. How many games will my team play?**

Each team is guaranteed three games.

### **15. How do I pre-register my team?**

Team captains for each team MUST attend a pre-registration session. At the pre-registration session, team captains will receive their team's registration package, including their game schedule.

**16. What support facilities does Downsview Park's Sports Centre offer, e.g., showers, change rooms, restaurant, etc.?**

Downsview Park's Sports Centre offers many team change rooms (that can be secured) with shower and washroom facilities as well as two public washrooms.

Located at the entrance to The Hangar is The Hangar Grill, a full service restaurant and snack bar with cable sports on multiple TVs. Public washrooms also provided.
